Argument Writing Argument writing is writing that is produced by an author that has a goal in mind. The author is trying to convince the reader to take some sort of action.


Argument Writing Includes • Reasoning: Readers must recognize why this topic and resulting action is important. **Evidence:** Anecdotes, testimonials, stats, and text evidence to support <u>ALL</u> claims Claim = the author's position on the topic. Fair treatment of the <u>counter claim</u>. This means explain what it is and why people think that. **Rebuttal:** A logical way to disprove the counter claim.
