

- Us, we, our





BODY PARAGRAPHS

1. Provide supporting evidence. (Remember: do not dead quote. If it looks like this . “ that is a dead quote.

Instead do this:

Author/researcher/whoever (insert name) references this in their article/study/ research (insert title if possible) by saying/ and proves/ concluding, “.....”(P#).

3. Explain WHY or HOW the evidence you quoted was important to the topic.

4. Rinse and repeat. EACH BODY PARAGRAPH needs 2 evidence.

BODY PARAGRAPHS


